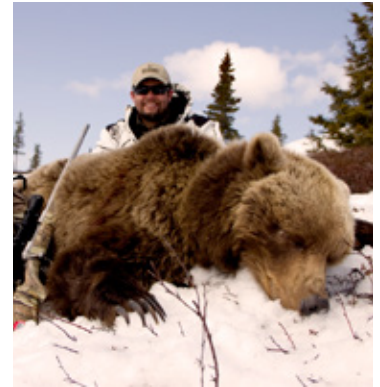
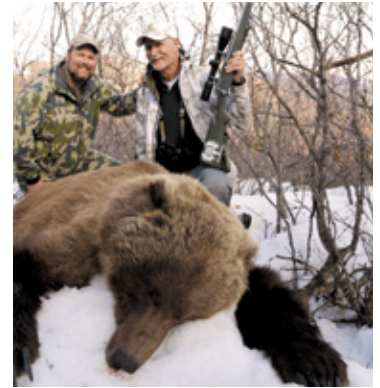


ALASKA SPRING SNOW BROWN BEAR



One of the most rewarding and successful brown bear hunts in Alaska is the early spring hunt on the snow. These hunts are done in mid to late April when the bears are just digging out of their dens. We use aircraft to locate the dens and then snowmobile or hike to the area and glass for the bears that usually hang out on the dens for a few days after digging out. These hunts are done from a comfortable cabin base camp and then spike camps if needed. Some seasons there is adequate snow which allows us to use snowmobiles to cover many miles each day checking den sites or go cross country to the dens located from the air. This is a very effective means of putting our clients on the bears and taking big boars with perfect spring hides. Its also a great adventure and overall a tremendous Alaskan hunting experience.
